India's domestic passenger demand climbs 14.8% in June: IATA

The International Air Transport Association (IATA) announced that the post-COVID recovery momentum continued in June for passenger markets. Indian airlines' domestic demand climbed 14.8% in June and was 1.3% above the June 2019 level. The total traffic in June 2023 (measured in revenue passenger kilometers or RPKs) rose 31.0% compared to June 2022. Globally, traffic is now at 94.2% of pre-COVID levels. For the first half of 2023, total traffic was up 47.2% compared to the year-ago period.



GNTO witnesses 209% Y-O-Y growth in overnights by Indians in 2022

As per data from the German National Tourist Board, the country has seen a growth of 209 per cent in overnight stays by Indians in 2022 compared to the previous year. The German National Tourist Office (GNTO) and German Embassy in



India addressed the press to showcase Germany as a must-visit destination. In 2022, Indians spend a total of 623,363 nights in Germany (2021: 201,194). The record level of 2019 with 961,656 has not yet been reached. "However we have already reached 65 per cent of the level of 2019, leaving room for continuous growth as Indians return to travelling. There is huge demand among Indians for international travel," said Romit Theophilus, Director – India, German National Tourist Office.
