DGCA grants Goa's Mopa airport aerodrome license

The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has granted Goa's Mopa airport the aerodrome license to enable it to commence flight operations. The license was issued on Wednesday for the state's second airport ahead of its inauguration.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi is expected to inaugurate the greenfield airport. An IndiGo A-320 aircraft from Mumbai has flown to the Mopa airport as part of the mandatory navigation system testing.

The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has lifted the 50% flight cap on Ajay Singhpromoted SpiceJet for the winter schedule, allowing it to operate at its full capacity. The DGCA had directed the troubled carrier to operate at half its capacity during the summer schedule in July, following multiple technical snags reported on its flights.

Qatar to scrap pre-arrival COVID-19 tests before World Cup

Qatar is to drop pre-arrival COVID-19 tests before the World Cup, the Health Ministry said,



weeks after announcing that the million-plus incoming fans do not need vaccinations. The latest relaxation in anti-COVID measures will take effect on November 1, 19 days before the first World Cup on Arab territory starts on November 20.

"Visitors are no longer required to present a negative COVID-19 PCR or Rapid Antigen Test result before travelling to Qatar," a statement said.
